Griffin's Lair Vineyard Sonoma Coast

Judicious extraction during fermentation and aging in neutral French Oak Barrels ensure that this wine is a pure expression of Sonoma Coast Syrah. This southwest-facing hillside is covered in coarse sand & gravel which allows these vines to dig deeply and hang on tight to this extremely windy slope. Traditional winemaking techniques, such as utilizing indigenous yeasts, foot-crushing 100% whole-cluster, judicious extraction during fermentation and aging in neutral French Oak Barrels ensure that this wine is a pure expression of Sonoma Coast Syrah.

Dark salty black fruit wrapped in leather with a thick aroma of ripe black fruit, salted plums & nori. The palate is thick and textured with an urgency of bright fruit and fresh sea air. Purely California Syrah grown in a cool windy place powerful and dense with a nice lift of freshness and verve.
