The Majik Vineyard is a mere 1 acre of vines high up on a ridge in the Sebastopol Hills. Planted in 2000 to a spicy selection of clone 7, this tiny planting has been a monumental vineyard in terms of relearning the limits of ripeness in Syrah grown in west county. Always delicate with savory olive-scented meaty flavors, but always gorgeous in its purity of fruit and clarity of site and variety.

Tasting Note:

The density and precision of 2019 is impressive. With all of the exotic aromas of cured meat, black pepper and purple flowers that you would expect from this cool west county hilltop are there along with some gorgeous blue flowers and tarry notes that we only see in the special vintages. Subtle and smooth, this is a Syrah lovers wine. Rich and complex with mouth-watering acidity and verve, but concentrated and surprisingly powerful for such a delicate wine.
