The Bearg Vineyard wines are the culmination of years of research, lots of international travel and lots and lots of hard work. The wines from this Biodynamically farmed site have exceeded all of our expectations. The mountain soils and high elevation character has proven to be ideal for the alpine varieties that we chose to plant. But most of all it is the dedication, tireless hard work, patience and passion of Kerry Bearg and his family that have given us the gift of planting this vineyard exactly the way we wanted to.

The Trousseau Noir is planted in three different soil types, the majority is planted in red clay and Kidd-forward-cohasset series soils a smaller block is on an old creekbed, loaded with gravel and shallow silty soils and the final block is in deeper Goulding -Toomes clay loam. We planted four different selections of material from a couple of our favorite Trousseau vineyards in California & France.

Blood orange, leather, forest floor, red berries and pencil lead aromas leap from this light colored but intensely flavored wine. The wine is like a cloud of alpine berries floating through a stand of pine trees. Delicate but wild, tart but supple, very much alive and continuously unravelling and evolving in your glass.
